

## **OUTDOOR HOCKEY AND SKATING RINKS**

Nine of the major parks in the City of Pointe-Claire have public skating rinks, which are lit at night, for skating and playing hockey. These are available for the public to enjoy a game of shinny hockey or recreational skating.

The rinks are in operation from late December until the end of February, weather permitting. With our climate, the season is sometimes very short and often unpredictable.

Rinks are located in the following parks. Listed beside each park is the phone number for the chalet to inquire about rink conditions and scheduled events on the main hockey rink.

Each of the above parks has a chalet with changing room facilities except Seigniory Park. At Seigniory, the changing room is located at the back of the school; their specific hours of operation are posted. All these parks are staffed by Public Works employees. Listed below are the days and times that the chalets are opened and staffed:

Please note that due to weather and ice conditions, occasional maintenance work may be required during these times.

At each park, there are some scheduled activities from Monday to Thursday nights and occasionally, Saturday mornings on the main hockey rink including hockey and ringette practices, boot hockey and broomball games. These limited activities are scheduled so as to allow open time for the general public. Friday nights, Saturday after 11 a.m. and Sundays are available exclusively for the general public.
